RESOLUTION NO. 2017-026

APPROVING THE PNP-UESB RESOLUTION NO. 2016-099 DATED AUGUST 4, 2016
THAT PRESCRIBES THE MINIMUM STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR HEAVY
DUTY MULTI-FUNCTION PHOTOCOPYING MACHINE

WHEREAS, Section 14, Paragraphs (i) and (m) of Republic Act No. 6975 as amended by Section 5, Sub-Paragraphs (5) and (8) of the Republic Act No. 8551, empowers the Commission to “approve or modify plans and programs on education and training, logistical requirements, communications, records, information system, crime laboratory, crime prevention and crime reporting as well as prescribe minimum standards for arms, equipment and uniforms and, after consultation with the Philippine Heraldry Commission, for insignia of ranks, awards and medals of honor”;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforecited legal prescription, the PNP, through Uniform and Equipment Standardization Board (UESB) Resolution No. 2016-099 dated August 4, 2016, has favorably submitted and indorsed the proposed standard specifications for Heavy Duty Multi-Function Photocopying Machine for consideration and approval by the Commission;

WHEREAS, the subject UESB proposed specification refers to the description and parameter requirements of an office machine which incorporates the functionality of multiple devices in one, so as to have smaller footprint in a home or small business setting and to provide centralized document management/distribution/production in a large-office setting;

WHEREAS, the PNP UESB subject proposed specifications will be used in the PNP One-Stop Shop which is a facility providing all the requirements for the application and renewal of permits, licenses, clearances and other frontline services. It can also be used by the PNP Finance Service, Pensioners and Retirees Benefits Service (PBRs) and other customer-related offices. It is also included in the PNP’s 10-year Modernization Plan;

WHEREAS, the PNP Uniform and Equipment Standardization Board (UESB) Chairman has certified that the proposed minimum standard specifications for Heavy Duty Multi-Function Photocopying Machine are not tailored-fit specifications to any particular commercial brand of product in the market;

WHEREAS, after thorough review and evaluation, the Commission has determined that the Heavy Duty Multi-Function Photocopying Machine specifications are in order and conform with the requirements of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by RA No. 8551 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations, and all existing policies and issuances of the Commission, to meet the requirements of the PNP;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission, in the exercise of its statutory powers to administer and control the PNP, HAS RESOLVED TO APPROVE, AS IT HEREBY APPROVES, the PNP-UESB Resolution No. 2016-099, dated August 4, 2016, that prescribes the minimum standard specifications for Heavy Duty Multi-Function Photocopying Machine, with slight modification, to read as follows:


I. DESCRIPTION:

The Heavy Duty Multi-function Photocopying Machine is a device that performs a variety of other functions that would otherwise be carried out by separate peripheral devices such as printer, scanner and facsimile machine.






