2. According to the US-CERT advisory, Google has released security updates for Chrome to address vulnerabilities that an attacker could exploit to take control of the affected system.

3. In light of the foregoing, PNP personnel are encouraged to update Google Chrome as soon as possible in order to protect networks from malicious cyber actors (See attached step-by-step instructions).

4. To that end, the following security measures are recommended by this Service to help protect against becoming a victim of malicious cyber actors:

- a. Implement Multi-Factor Authentication on accounts and devices to reduce the likelihood of an attack;
- b. On a regular basis, update software patches and packages;
- c. Consider Your Options Before You Click; and
- d. Make use of strong passwords.
